

SAFETY NET MENTOR PROGRAM REIMBURSEMENT CRITERIA

MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT

- A. If you and your mentee live in the same town (Provo/Provo, etc.) you may be reimbursed for over 10 miles per activity.
- B. If your mentee lives in a different town than you (Provo/Pleasant Grove, etc.) you may be reimbursed for all mentor-related mileage.
- C. Keep track of the following information: **Date, activity and mileage** for each activity. You may mail them or bring them to the Safety Net office, or bring them to Inservice Meetings.

ACTIVITY REIMBURSEMENT

- A. Educational activities
- B. Cultural activities
- C. Recreational activities
- D. Service activities

YOU WILL NEED TO SAVE AND TURN IN RECEIPTS FOR REIMBURSEMENT.

Mentors are encouraged to plan most activities under the “cheap or free” guidelines in the Mentor Activity Suggestions sheet in the back of the Mentor binder. We do not wish to build mentor relationships on the basis of expensive activities and gifts.

It is imperative that good judgment prevail in the selection of mentor/mentee activities. For instance, **movies, videos, TV and video games are an easy activity, but in most cases, not encouraged, because they leave little time for communication between mentor and mentee.**
